The above condition existed until September 5 and 6, 1920, when a rodeo was held in Buffalo Pasture about two miles south of the 101 Ranch, by the Miller Brothers. Joe C. Miller, on this occasion, wrote a personal letter to all the Old Strip cowboys he could locate." So was the beginning of the Cherokee Strip Cowpunchers' Association.
